

HELPFUL HOMEWORK HINTS

- Assume they have H.W. every day. Help them maintain a “can-do” attitude!**
- Ask kids if they understand their H.W. If they don’t work on a couple of examples together**
- Ask kids to show you their H.W., before and after the teacher grades it. See if your helping**
- Keep in touch with your students teachers. Ask about their classes (follow their pacing chart)**
 - **Ask how you can support their efforts (i.e. Flashcards, spelling, etc.)**
- Remember, you and their teachers want the same thing – to help all students learn.**
- Don’t be afraid to get in touch with the teacher if you and your students don’t get it. [the answer is never, “I can’t help you”]**
- Don’t do your students work for them. Help them to help themselves.**
- Praise your students for doing well. Make praise a habit.**
- Help older students organize their assignments by recording them on calendars or planners, along with due dates, dates submitted, etc. (Model Organization, Good Study Habits, and a solid work ethic)**
